'Access to Headington' roadworks on Headley Way'

We have been informed that construction to provide new signalised junctions replacing the roundabouts for the JR access and the double mini roundabouts at Marsh Lane, as well as improved cycle infrastructure, along the length of Headley Way/Cherwell Drive between London Road and Oxford Road will take place from May 14th 2018 until March 2019.

Roadworks around Headington Hospitals

Roadworks are to begin on Headley Way Monday 14th May.

The works will start with temporary lights on the junction of Marsh Lane/Headley Way for three weeks whilst central islands are removed and reinstated with a temporary road surface.

Temporary lights will then move to the JR access roundabout on Monday 4th June for two weeks, whilst the existing pedestrian crossing is disconnected and removed along with the remaining central islands and reinstated with a temporary road surface.

After this the remainder of the works will take place on narrow lanes between Headley Way and London Road.
